## PARISH COUNCIL - MARCH

The council met on March 18<sup>th</sup> to gather information to help in developing a plan going forward. Information was given on the current state of pastor vacancies. There are quite a few in the area in both the Eastern ND Synod Conference and the UCC. Representatives from the Synod and UCC offices talked about the idea of thinking "outside the box" and looking at collaborating going forward. There was discussion on who can perform the different types of duties such as communion, funerals, and weddings. Profiles will be submitted for review by Pastors that are looking for a call. There was mention of interest by someone in helping out at LMH during the interim. Parish council members discussed some local people to contact for possible partnerships and calls were divided.

## PARISH COUNCIL - APRIL

The council met on April 24<sup>th</sup>. There was discussion on the person that is interested in providing chaplaincy services at LMH one day per week. This will be pursued. Loretta Larson has worked hard to secure pulpit supply and worship leaders for the summer months. Most Sundays are covered through August. Compensation was agreed upon. Congregation members will fill in the days not covered. Both congregations will submit their normal quarterly contributions to the parish until further notice. Congregational profiles written by Jackee and Laura were reviewed. And will be submitted. Both churches have at least two members for a call committee and are looking for a couple more. That group will lead the process going forward.
